



## Welcome to Granite Mountain Preserve

Granite Mountain Preserve is a 400+ acre assemblage of land owned by the Hudson Highlands Land Trust (HHLT). Our goal for the Preserve is to protect wildlife habitat and drinking water, while also serving as a recreational resource for the community. The Preserve is open from dawn to dusk for many types of non-motorized public recreation.

The following outlines some of the permitted and prohibited uses at the Preserve<sup>1</sup>:

<p><b>Hiking</b> is permitted from dawn to dusk. Users must remain on established, marked trails.</p> <p><b>Dogs on leash</b> are permitted. Dogs must remain under control of their owners. All pet waste must be packed out.</p> <p><b>Horseback riding</b> is permitted. Note that there are no equestrian / trailer parking areas at the Preserve.</p> <p><b>Fishing</b> consistent with state law is permitted.</p>	<p><b>Motorized vehicles</b> are prohibited. This includes, but is not limited to, motorbikes, ATVs, and snowmobiles.</p> <p><b>Collection of plants, wildlife, minerals, and historical/cultural artifacts</b> by the public is prohibited.</p> <p><b>Trapping, swimming, dumping, and rock climbing</b> are all prohibited.</p> <p><b>Mountain bikes</b> are prohibited.</p>
<p><b>Hunting / firearms, camping, and creation of campfires</b> are all <b>prohibited EXCEPT</b> with the express prior written permission of the Hudson Highlands Land Trust.</p>
